Superintendent Kenworthy reviewed the following millage information:

- The Certified County Tax Roll for Okeechobee County is \$2,098,620,428.00. This is an increase from the previous year of \$214,930,489.00 or 11.4%. For millage purposes, 96% of the certified tax roll is used which is \$2,014,675,611.00, an increase of \$206,333,270.00.
- The Required Local Effort millage is set by the state at 4.111, a decrease of 0.247 mills from last year, and is expected to generate \$8,282,331.00 which is an increase of \$401,575.00.
- The maximum Discretionary Local Effort millage rate of 0.748 is also set by the state and is expected to generate \$1,506,977.00, an increase of \$154,337.00. Levying this Local Effort millage makes the District eligible to receive Millage Compression funding from the state.
- The Capital Improvement Effort millage is unchanged from last year at 1.50 mills and is expected to yield an estimated \$3,022,013.00, an increase of \$309,499.00.
- The total local tax receipts for the Operating Fund are expected to be \$9,789,308.00, an increase of \$555,912.00 over last year's receipts. The total combined tax receipts, including Capital Improvement, are \$12,811,321.00 which is an increase of \$865,411.00 from last year.

- The Debt Service Budget is \$42,712, a decrease of (\$149,825).
- The Capital Projects Budget is \$6,420,544, an increase of \$1,210,194.
- The Food Service Budget is \$4,235,155, an increase of \$138,954.
- The Federal Programs Budget is \$6,511,066, an increase of \$327,872.
- The Total Budget is \$71,928,092, an increase of \$836,467.
- It is expected that the total Federal Through State revenue will be \$602,377, a decrease of (\$601).
- The total State FEFP, Lottery, and Categorical funding is estimated at \$30,916,700 which is an increase of \$469,481 over last year's budget.

- The total State Funds expected are \$38,291,127, an increase of \$394,613.
- The total for all revenue sources is \$50,396,620, an increase of \$246,299 over last year's budget.
- This year's Cost Center appropriations are \$40,282,426. Appropriations for State and Local Projects totals \$11,737,946. Total Appropriations are estimated to be \$52,020,372.
- Total Appropriations combined with Projects and Categoricals Forward, and Encumbrances Forward, produces an estimated ending fund balance is \$2,224,905.
- The Total Appropriations & Balances equals the Total Revenues at \$54,718,615.
- The Debt Service Budget is \$42,712 which is equal to the Debt Service Revenue plus the Beginning Fund Balance.
