Second Step curriculum is used K-8 weekly to cover the topics above. The Mental Health and Behavioral Supports Department creates monthly wellness videos that meet the mandate. D.A.R.E materials are incorporated into these wellness videos. The AlcoholEDU modules also cover vaping and prescription drug use and abuse. Botvin Life Skills curriculum is used by our

mental health partners in specific schools based on need. The First Time Offender Program is offered as needed in grades 6-12.

To improve the continuity of instruction and to ensure that it is being implemented across each school campus, videos are shown at a time certain. In order to do this by time rather than by course, the study hall course code is being used as a replacement for homeroom. The course code for Homeroom is not recognized by FLDOE. The local code for Homeroom is HOE2907.
