On a motion by India Riedel, seconded by David Williams, the Board voted 4-0 in favor to approve the Minutes of the organizational and regular meeting held on November 12, 2013.

Chairman Arnold asked if there were any changes, additions, or deletions to *Items for Action*. None were requested.

Superintendent Kenworthy recommended the expulsion of #14-01, 9<sup>th</sup> grade student at Okeechobee Achievement Academy, for the remainder of the 2013-14 school year, and approval of the proposed final order based on the following act of misconduct and violation of the *Code of Student Conduct*:

- Section B Alcohol and Drugs
  - 1. Possessing (including possession after use when the substance is still in the body), using and/or procuring, selling or dispensing on school premises, school buses, or at any school activity or school-related function of:
    - b. Any substance controlled by F.S. 893 or 877.111 (available upon request).

A motion to approve the Superintendent's recommendation was made by David Williams and seconded by Gay Carlton. Tracy Downing, Director of Student Services, reported that the student was enrolled in the Alternative Education Program at the time the violation occurred. The student resides in a neighboring county, and is not currently enrolled in any alternative or home education program. Chairman Arnold asked if anyone was present to represent #14-01 and after seeing no one, called for a vote by the Board. The Board voted 4-0 in favor to expel #14-01, 9<sup>th</sup> grade student at Okeechobee Achievement Academy, for the remainder of the 2013-14 school year, and to issue a final order based on the following act of misconduct and violation of the *Code of Student Conduct*: Section B(1)(b).

Superintendent Kenworthy recommended that the Board ratify the contract Agreement with the Okeechobee County Education Association #1604 for the Classified Personnel Bargaining Unit effective July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014, including the following Salary Schedules:

A motion to approve the recommendation was made by India Riedel and seconded by Gay Carlton. Superintendent Kenworthy reported that the Classified Bargaining Unit ratified the contract on November 22, 2013, by a vote of 188 in favor and 2 opposed. The Board voted 4-0 in favor to ratify the contract Agreement with the Okeechobee County Education Association #1604 for the Classified Personnel Bargaining Unit effective July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014, including the Salary Schedules listed above. Member India Riedel commented she is pleased that the Classified Personnel contract was completed. Superintendent Kenworthy agreed and added that he hopes the Instructional Contract can be resolved as soon as possible.

The School Board of Okeechobee County, Florida, hereby certifies that pursuant to a legal notice, a meeting for public hearing was held in Room 303 of the School Board Administrative Office, 700 S.W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, at 6:00 p.m. in the City of Okeechobee on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2013, for the purpose of discussing amendment of Board Policies 5.27 <u>Homeless Students</u>, 6.70 <u>Personnel Files</u>, and 6.90 <u>School Board Employees with HIV, AIDS, or Other Communicable Diseases</u>. The Board further certifies that it remained in session until 7:05 p.m. and there appeared no one at said hearing to oppose or discuss these policy changes.

On the recommendation of Superintendent Kenworthy and a motion by David Williams, seconded by India Riedel, the Board voted 4-0 in favor to amend School Board Policy 5.27 <u>Homeless Students</u> to include a definition of *Certified Homeless Youth*. Advertisement of intent to amend Policy 5.27 was approved by the School Board on November 12, 2013, and legally advertised to the public on November 13, 2013, as required by Chapter 120, Administrative Procedures Act, Florida Statutes.

On the recommendation of Superintendent Kenworthy and a motion by Gay Carlton, seconded by India Riedel, the Board voted 4-0 in favor to amend School Board Policy 6.70 <u>Personnel Files</u> to bring the policy into agreement with current statutes governing instructional personnel files. Advertisement of intent

to amend Policy 6.70 was approved by the School Board on November 12, 2013, and legally advertised to the public on November 13, 2013, as required by Chapter 120, Administrative Procedures Act, Florida Statutes.

On the recommendation of Superintendent Kenworthy and a motion by Gay Carlton, seconded by David Williams, the Board voted 4-0 in favor to amend School Board Policy 6.90 <u>School Board Employees with HIV, AIDS, or Other Communicable Diseases</u> to bring the policy into agreement with current statutes regarding protection of employees from exposure to infectious diseases and accommodations for infected employees. Advertisement of intent to amend Policy 6.90 was approved by the School Board on November 12, 2013, and legally advertised to the public on November 13, 2013, as required by Chapter 120, Administrative Procedures Act, Florida Statutes.

Member India Riedel asked if any calls were received regarding any of the School Board Policy changes listed above, and Mr. Kenworthy replied that no responses were received from employees or the public.

On the recommendation of Superintendent Kenworthy and a motion by India Riedel, seconded by Gay Carlton, the Board voted 4-0 in favor to approve a Separation Agreement and General Release with Stephanie Rowley.
