Adoption of Board Policy 2.201 Emergency Policy Relating to School Board Meetings

- I. This policy defines School Board meetings during the COVID-19 health emergency.
- II. The proposed policy is required based on the Governor's Executive Order Number 20-69 relating to COVID-19.
- III. Legal authority for this policy is F.S. 120.54(4), 120.81(1), 1001.32(2), 1001.42(28). Laws implemented are F.S. 120.54(4), 1001.41(1) & (3), 1001.42, including (8), 1001.43, including (10), 1001.48, 1001.49, 1001.51.
- IV. This policy amendment will not affect individuals from an economic standpoint.
